

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES February 20, 2018**

CALL TO ORDER:

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Bob Anthony at 7:00 P.M. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Jim Benoit, Mike Gallagher and Joe Lisa. Judy Lizza, Manager and Kathy Labrum, Township Solicitor were also in attendance. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted by Bob Anthony.

Announcement by Bob Anthony that the Board had met in Executive Session prior to the meeting to discuss personnel.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Bob Anthony motioned to approve the December 19, 2017 Board of Supervisors' Meeting Minutes, the January 2, 2018 Reorganization Meeting Minutes, and the February 6, 2018 Work Session Minutes. The motion was seconded by Mike Gallagher. All were in favor. Motion carried.

MANAGER'S REPORT:

Judy Lizza gave a summary of the report. The Comprehensive Plan update is almost complete. Final reviews and comments to be received from Delaware and Chester Counties, School Districts, and neighboring municipalities. Final adoption by April/May. A brief discussion of the written decision by Westtown Township to Toll Brothers for the Conditional Use of Crebilly Farm tract. A continued issue for Thornbury Township will be Westtown's requirement of a collector/connector road from Skiles Blvd. through the tract with an alignment to Bridlewood Blvd. A copy of the complete manager's report is on file for your review.

AGENDA BUSINESS:

Mowing Contract award for Township Parks

Bob Anthony moved to move to award the Park Maintenance Contract with TS Morris Landscaping for the years April 1, 2018- March 31, 2020. Seconded by Jim Benoit. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Resolution 2018-11 Policy change request to the Governor regarding laws and regulations of Interstate and Intrastate oil and gas pipelines

Bob Anthony moved to approve Resolution 2018-11. Seconded by Joe Lisa. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Two Year Lease for Ann's Parcel/Squire Cheyney Park with Peter Flynn

Bob Anthony moved to approve the two year lease for Pete's Produce Farm (Peter Flynn) to farm Ann's Parcel and hay bale Squire Cheyney Park under the contract terms - approved February 2018. Seconded by Jim Benoit. All were in favor. Motion carried.

APPROVAL OF THE BILL LIST

Bob Anthony presented for approval the bill list for January in the amount of \$143,509.94 and the bill list for February in the amount of \$ 140,512.21 including
