

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
WORK SESSION**

MINUTES – February 6, 2018

The Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Bob Anthony, Chairman, Jim Benoit, Vice-Chairman, Joe Lisa, Bill Reilly and Michael Gallagher. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. Discussion of the Caln-Nether Meeting from January 30th

The Board discussed the meeting. The applicant was to be notified that the discussion will not progress unless there is an equitable owner/operator for the site.

2. WEGO New Website

Judy Lizza noted that the new website will be called Crime Watch and will be operational soon. Discussion of available modules that could be posted was discussed. Additional information to be shared with the Police Commission at their March meeting.

3. Stolfuz Trailer Sales 1335 Wilmington Pike

Judy Lizza wanted to update the Board of the work at 1335 Wilmington Pike. All permits are in Birmingham Township and only the Stormwater Permit is in Thornbury Township.

4. Mowing Contract award scheduled for February 20th meeting

Judy Lizza noted that seven packets were picked up and the bids will be opened on 2/14/18. The contract award to be scheduled at the next Board meeting.

5. Request for enactment of Resolution from East Goshen regarding Pipelines

Kathy Labrum drafted a resolution for the board to consider approving to support our neighboring Township regarding the pipelines. This will be placed for consideration at the February meeting.

6. Deltaone Consulting Firm on behalf of Giant Foods seeking referendum for liquor sales in Township

Judy Lizza updated the Board on the request from Deltaone and that they need 25% of signatures from the last election.

OTHER MATTERS:


Resident, Dan Grey just wanted some more information from the Board regarding the Caln-Nether meeting.
