

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY

WORK SESSION**

MINUTES –June 7, 2016

The Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Robert Anthony, Chairman; Mike Gallagher, Joe Lisa and Bill Reilly. Also in attendance were Judy Lizza, Township Manager, Teresa DeStefano, Township Secretary, and Kathy Labrum Township Solicitor.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. On-Lot Disposal System Maintenance Program

Judy Lizza explained to the Board that the Township will be sending out a letter to all residents that have onsite sewage systems. Our ordinance states that all systems need to be pumped at least once every three years by a Chester County Health Department license septic tank contractor.

2. Regional Police Feasibility Study discussion

Bob Anthony mentioned that he attended a meeting about regionalization of the police department with WCACOG. A representative was there from The Pennsylvania Governor's Center and will be conducting a study of boroughs and townships within the scope of the proposed region police force.

3. Penn Oaks Tennis Club concept proposal

Judy Lizza stated that the Penn Oaks Tennis Club would like to put a dome over the Tennis Courts to have a four season use.

4. Unlimited Trucking bond reduction request

Judy Lizza noted that Unlimited Trucking has requested a bond reduction. The Board discussed the issues and feel since they have been our contractor for several years to consider the request. This item will be on the agenda for the next meeting.


OTHER MATTERS: None
