

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
WORK SESSION**

MINUTES –March 7, 2017

The Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Robert Anthony, Chairman; Jim Benoit, Vice-Chairman Mike Gallagher, Bill Reilly and Joe Lisa. Also in attendance were Judy Lizza, Township Manager; Teresa DeStefano, Township Secretary; Mike Conrad, Township Engineer; and Kathy Labrum, Township Solicitor.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. Rokeby Farm, 1300 S. Concord Road Resolution

Judy Lizza gave a brief update on the Resolution 2017-12 of the Final Land Development Approval for Rokeby Farm. Kathy Labrum was ok with approving this Resolution with just one amendment. Removing condition number 3.

2. Comprehensive Plan Public Outreach Meeting April 4 at the Concept School 7 PM

Judy Lizza noted that this is just an announcement that the next Comprehensive Plan meeting on April 4, 2017 will be at the Concept School and the Township will be sending an email blast to invite all residents.

3. Neff Construction contract extension request

Judy Lizza stated that this extension will be on the next Board meeting for approval.

4. Tom Morris contract extension request

Judy Lizza stated that this extension will be on the next Board meeting for approval.

5. Representative Comitta request to attend March 21 meeting

Judy Lizza gave an update that Representative Comitta cannot attend our March 21, 2017 meeting due to a conflict.

6. Request for Resolution consideration regarding Crebilly Farm Application in Westtown

Judy Lizza noted that the group, Neighbors of Crebilly Farms would like all surrounding Townships to pass a Resolution expressing support for the preservation of Crebilly farm in Westtown. The Board discussed the options and Kathy Labrum doesn't recommend doing this at this time. The Resolution will not be considered.

7. Traffic Calming

A. Bridlewood Blvd. Updated plan for discussion

Judy Lizza gave a brief update on the report from Pennoni Associates of the Bridlewood Traffic Calming Improvements that the Board can present to

Westtown. It was suggested that the Board let Westtown know that the Township has a plan in place.
The Board also suggested that Judy Lizza set up a meeting with the residents to inform them of our plan.

B. New Study for William Penn Blvd., S. Concord Rd., Old Bailey Lane

Judy Lizza noted that Wendy Kelley, from Pennoni Associates, is conducting a road safety study and will create a report for the Township. The report is expected April/May.

OTHER MATTERS:


There was none.
