How to make a comment to a Township Board or Commission:

- 1) The Chair will announce that the Board or Commission will now hear public comment either on a specific issue or of a general nature.
- 2) A person wishing to speak will be recognized by the Chair prior to speaking.
- 3) Once you have been recognized by the Chair, state your name and address for the record.
- 4) Public comment is limited to three (3) minutes to either ask a question, make a statement or both.
