

**THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES –February 18, 2014**

I. CALL TO ORDER

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Bob Anthony at 7:00 P.M. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. In attendance were Supervisors Bob Anthony, Chairman; Jim Benoit, Vice-Chairman; William Reilly, and Mike Gallagher. Kathy Labrum, Solicitor; and Teresa DeStefano, Township Administrator, were also in attendance. There was one sign guess.

II. POLICE REPORT – Chief Bernot

Chief Bernot mentioned that there have been a few incidents through the month, a few retail thefts from the Giant; also several DUI arrests on the South bound lanes on Route 202.

Bob Anthony inquired about the area.

Chief Bernot stated that one arrest was made at Route 202 and Greentree Road and the other was at the 1200 block of Wilmington Pike.

Chief Bernot also noted that the WEGO Police Department is having annual Got Drugs program where residents can turn in all unused or expired medication, the event will be held Saturday April 26, 2014 between 10am -2pm.

Chief Bernot wanted to mention that we have had an incredible winter this year and one issue that we realized is that the Township loses traffic signals. The Chief will be writing a proposal to request that the traffic signals at these intersections be generator ready. This will affect Thornbury and Westtown Townships. The two locations currently they are requesting are Route 202 and Route 926 and also Route 926 and Shiloh Road.

Mike Aiello questioned South Concord Road, Westtown –Thornton and Route 926.

Rich Acciavatti wanted to make anonymous donation of \$1,000 towards the generator.

Mike Aiello mentions that this year with all the snow we need to talk about the mailbox complaints. Mike suggested that we address this issue. And set up rules for the do's and don'ts in a snow storm.

Mike Aiello said that he had to get another truck to pick up a salt delivery since they couldn't supply the Township with salt. Since we are under a contract we should get a credit for the amount.

Bob Anthony will look into this matter.
