A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AGENCIES TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY SERVICES TO THORNBURY TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PA, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2014

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Thornbury Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania is responsible under the Second Class Township Code for the public safety of Township residents; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to fulfill its public safety responsibilities by appointing certain agencies that will provide rescue, ambulance and fire protection services to Thornbury Township, Chester County.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Thornbury Township Chester County that effective January 1, 2014:

- 1. The West Chester Borough Fire Department is appointed to provide fire protection and rescue services for Thornbury Township, Chester County.
- 2. Good Fellowship Ambulance and Concordville Ambulance will provide ambulance coverage for Thornbury Township, Chester County, as determined by the Chester County Department of Emergency Services.
- 3. The Westtown-East Goshen Regional Police Department is appointed to provide police services for Thornbury Township, Chester County.
- 4. The contact person between the appointed agencies and the Chester County Dept. of Emergency Services shall be the respective Fire Chief and Ambulance Chief.
