Re-organization Meeting

Regular Meeting

1. Approval of Minutes of December 12, 2012

The commission approved the minutes December 12, 2012.

2. Squire Cheyney Property

Molly Morrison reports that the Preservation Alliance for Greater Philadelphia working on the Squire Cheyney Property easement and should have it ready to be reviewed by the Historic Preservation Commission at its February meeting.

3. *The Gander* Articles

The next article will be about the house at 1400 East Street Road, for the spring issue.

4. Oral History Project

Frank Hash will be interviewed in the next two to three weeks. The commission discussed different ways of recording these interviews but at present will continue working with the Senior Center, but with an additional camera.

5. 2013 Budget

The commission agreed to have a program in June on the archaeology work that has been done at the Spackman Farm. The date and further details will be set at the February meeting.

6. Historic Resources Research Project

Chris Lang, Kris Walker, and Dick Webster will meet January 18 for a trial work session to evaluate conditions and establish guidelines. They later will split up and review the balance of the reports. Dick Webster will review Thornbury Estates separately. At the conclusion of the project, participants will discuss what they learned and use that information as the basis for an architectural history of the township.
