WORK SESSION**

MINUTES – August 5, 2014

The Thornbury Township Board of Supervisors' Work Session was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Thornbury Township meeting room. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. Thornbury Township LOGO Contest:

2. Curb & Sidewalk Replacement:

Jacqui Guenther stated that an issue was raised about who is responsible to maintain curbs in our Township. The discussion continued and it was decided that if the Township has not taken dedication of curbs the homeowner would be responsible for the maintenance and repair of existing curbs located on their property. Only the roads are the responsibility of the Township. Jacqui Guenther will check with Mike Conrad to see if the Township has taken dedication of any curbs in the Township.

3. Waln Run Subdivision Plans:

Jacqui Guenther noted that the Waln Run Subdivision Plans are now recorded and there is an issue of the pond that needs to be resolved and be recorded before we can move forward.

Jacqui Guenther stated that she had a preconstruction meeting with Macanga and reviewed the work that will be done next week on William Penn Blvd. and Deer Pointe Road.
